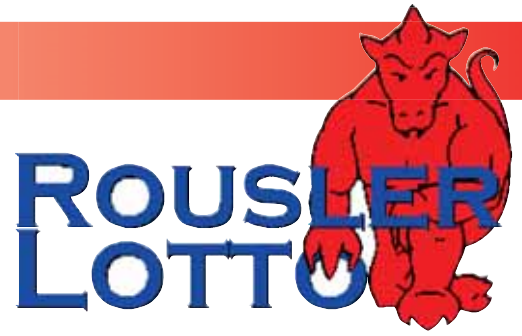




# BROMSGROVE SPORTING MONTHLY DRAW

## BROMSGROVE SPORTING LOTTERY

### Terms and Conditions

Bromsgrove Sporting Lottery, the official monthly lottery of Bromsgrove Sporting Ltd: Full Terms and Conditions: including complaints procedure.

1. These Terms and Conditions are the Lottery Rules. By entering the lottery, entrants agree to be bound by these rules.

2. This lottery is being promoted by and on behalf of Bromsgrove Sporting Ltd and is called Bromsgrove Sporting Lottery

3. For the purpose of the Gambling Act 2005, this lottery is defined as a 'Small Society Lottery.'

4. This lottery is licensed by Bromsgrove District Council under the 2005 Gambling Act, and is promoted by Matthew Humphries Bromsgrove Sporting Lottery, Bromsgrove Sporting Ltd, 483 Old Birmingham Road, Marlbrook, Bromsgrove B61 0HZ.

5. To enter the lottery, you must be a UK resident aged 16 (sixteen) or over. We reserve the right to ask for proof of age. No ticket may be sold to or by persons under 16 (sixteen) years of age.

6. There will be three guaranteed monthly winners. Additionally the team or club that sells the 1st and 2nd prize winning tickets will also win a prize.

7. All tickets shall be priced at £10.00. A maximum of 2000 tickets will be sold for each monthly draw.

8. All lottery entry sales are final and no refunds shall be made at any time. All entrants acknowledge that their payment of £10.00 per ticket to enter the lottery does not guarantee that they will win any prize.

9. The draw for the prizes will be made at Bromsgrove Sporting Football Club and will be held monthly. You do not need to be present at the draw to win the lottery.

10. If a cash prize is awarded, this will be made by cheque in the name of the entrant only.

11. Full payment for each ticket must be received in the form of cleared funds before the ticket can be entered into the draw. Only tickets for which full payment has been received is eligible to win the prize.

12. The winners of the lottery prizes will be notified officially by letter with the prize cheque enclosed. Additionally a newsletter will be produced periodically that will include the details of all winners since the last publication.

13. All entrants are solely responsible for providing Bromsgrove Sporting Limited with their accurate and up-to-date contact details and Bromsgrove Sporting Limited will be in no way liable for any failure or inability to contact any entrant due to any errors, omissions or inaccuracies in the contact details that the entrant has provided. In the event that an entrant changes their contact details, they will be solely responsible for advising Bromsgrove Sporting Limited of the change.

14. By accepting the prize, the winner agrees to take part in promotional activity and Bromsgrove Sporting Limited reserves the right to use the name and address of the winner, their photograph and audio and/or visual recordings of them in any publicity unless prior notification has been received.

15. Each player game number is unique.

16. Lottery membership can be cancelled at any time by notifying Bromsgrove Sporting Limited in writing, by phone or via e-mail.

17. In the event of the death of a player, any remaining credit in the player account will continue to be played until exhausted. No refunds are given to third parties. Should the player number win, the prize cheque will be issued to the deceased's bank account or, if notified, forwarded to the solicitor or Will executor who is dealing with the estate to include as an estate asset. In the case of releasing funds to an executor, written proof of executor status will be required.

18. Bromsgrove Sporting Limited shall not be liable to the member for any loss or damage suffered or arising from:-

- any delays or failures in the postal service or other delivery

methods used by Bromsgrove Sporting Limited, or the member from time to time.

- any delays or failures in any software or other systems used by Bromsgrove Sporting Limited for the administration of the lottery.

- any delays or failures in the Banking system used by Bromsgrove Sporting Limited or the member.

- any refusal by Bromsgrove Sporting Limited to accept registration of an individual as a member or the cancellation of a member.

- any failure to enter a chance into the draw.

- any event beyond the reasonable control of Bromsgrove Sporting Limited

19. Nothing within these terms and conditions shall create or should be construed as creating any form of contract between any entrant and Bromsgrove Sporting Limited.

Along with the acknowledgment we will include an initial estimate of the total time it will take to investigate and resolve any of the issues or problems raised in the complaint.

21. Bromsgrove Sporting Limited is committed to protecting the member's privacy. Data that is collected from the member is used lawfully in accordance with the Data Protection Act 1998 and is used solely for the purpose of processing lottery chances, subsequent entry into the lottery draw, and informing winners that they have won a prize.

26. Bromsgrove Sporting Limited reserves the right to disqualify any entrant if it has reasonable grounds to believe the entrant has breached any of these rules.
